## PAPER



We take all types of paper and cardboard.

Extra help – Paper can be tied up with twine or placed on cardboard boxes if you do not have a paper bag to put them in. Ask if you need paper bags for next time. We prefer shredded paper in boxes as we have to empty all plastic bags.

## Plastic



**ONLY number PET and HDPE plastics!!!** Look for these symbols usually found on the bottom of bottles. Other plastic types will contaminate these plastics in the recycling process. If we see other plastic types we have to fish them out of the trash truck.

Extra help: \* Remove and dispose of the lids on bottles \*Do NOT tie the handles of the bags in knots. \*Rinse out the containers \*Place your plastic into large bags instead of giving us a lot of small bags. \*We cannot recycle plastic shopping bags of any kind. \*No Rubbermaid, Tupperware or similar products. \* No CDs or CD cases \* No Styrofoam, such as egg cartons or meat trays.
